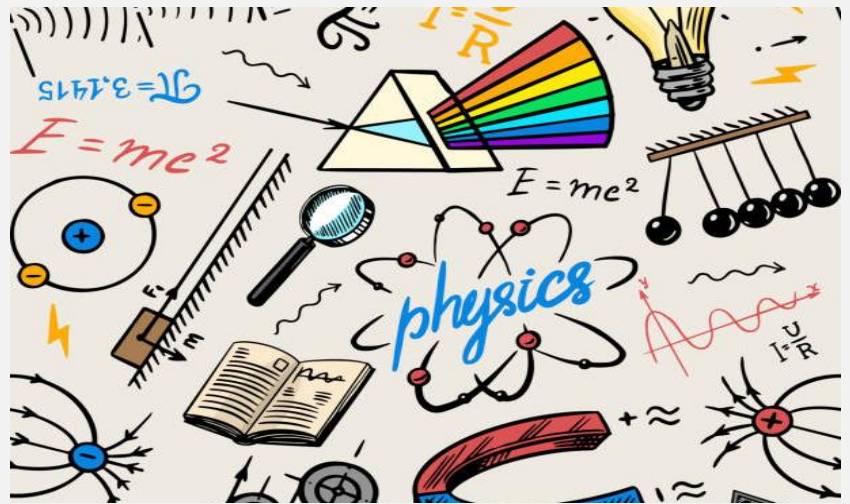
Velddrif HS has informed us that the interschools have been cancelled due to them not having enough teams. We are hard at work at getting a School for the matches. We are nearing an arrangement.



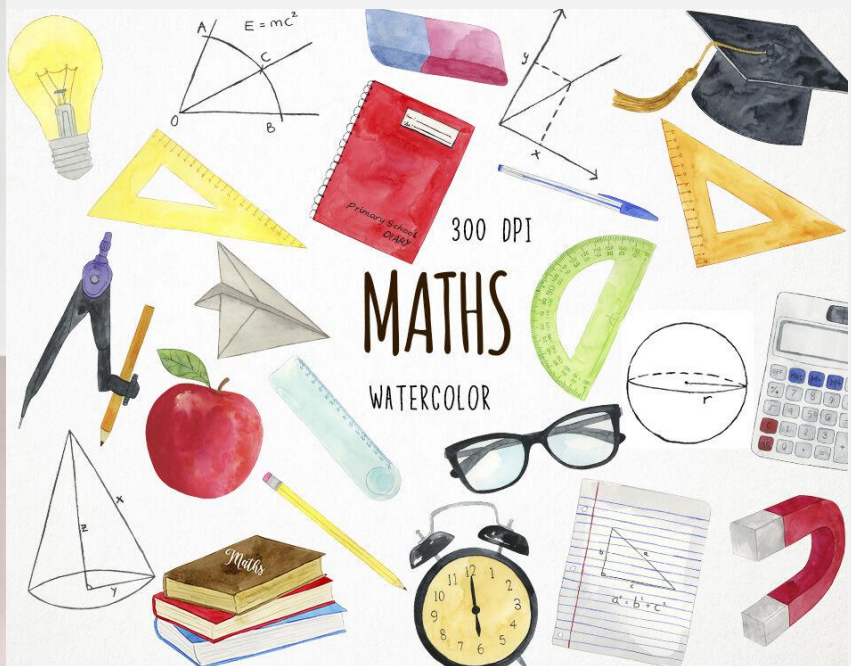

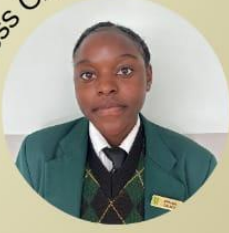
