Parents must pick up children from the homework centre class. No child is sent forward.

HOMEWORK CENTRE RULES

- Homework centre students are picked up at Seeskulpie.
- If a learner from LAPS uses the homework centre, Samantha must be informed at the Seeskulpie office.
- The costs amount to R1,400 per month.
- One month's written notice must be given if a learner will no longer use the homework centre.
- All after-school activities, including sports, must be communicated to the homework centre teacher.
- No toys are allowed.
- Only sportswear or regular clothes are allowed for outdoor play. Please label all items.
- No cell phones are allowed at the homework centre.
- We follow Longacres policy of one sport per quarter.
- Bring your own writing supplies that should be clearly marked.
- For any further inquiries, contact the respective teacher or Erika Theunissen.
- Homework center closes at 17:15.

We kindly ask all parents and visitors to our school to respect our learners by not smoking or using vulgar language near them.

Please arrange doctors' appointments and other meetings outside of school hours.

The constant calling of learners out of class is causing significant disruption and is unfair to those remaining in class. Any emergency or necessary appointments must be communicated at least 24 hours in advance; otherwise, those learners will not be called out of class.

An additional fee of R100 is charged when school fees are paid into the wrong account.

Longacres School's diaries can be purchased at the office at R50.

All visitors to Longacres Private School (including parents) must report to the office so that they can be accompanied by the school for our learners' safety.
