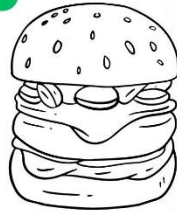

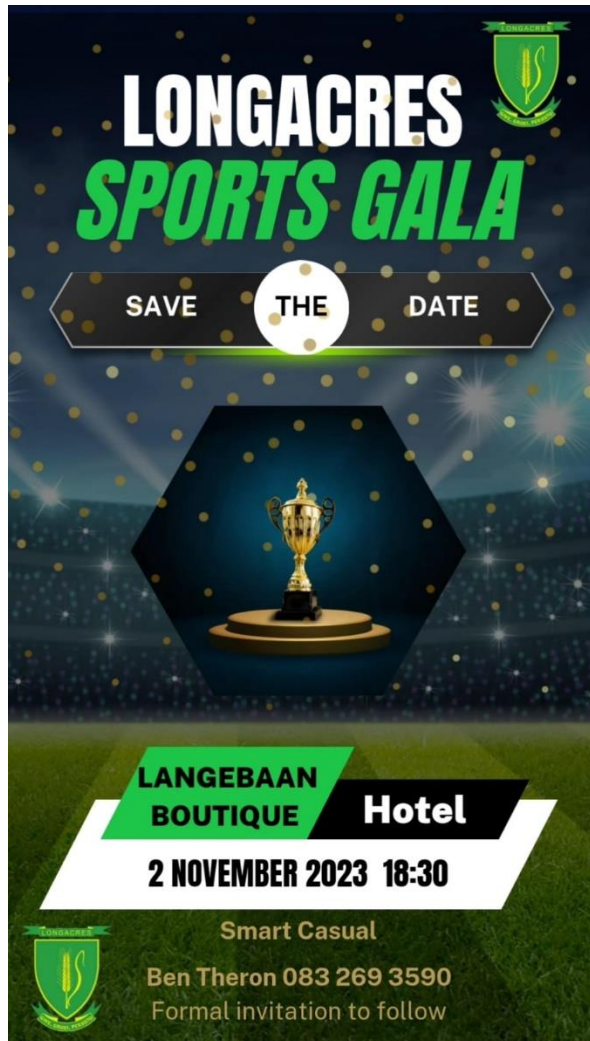
The foundation phase group will play on the left side of the rugby field and the senior phase group will play on the right side of the rugby field.
