Cricket Practice

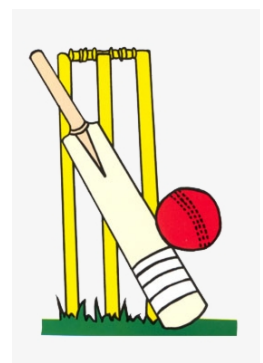
Cricket practice will start from 23 January. Our first matches are around the corner, so we need to start practicing as soon as possible.
