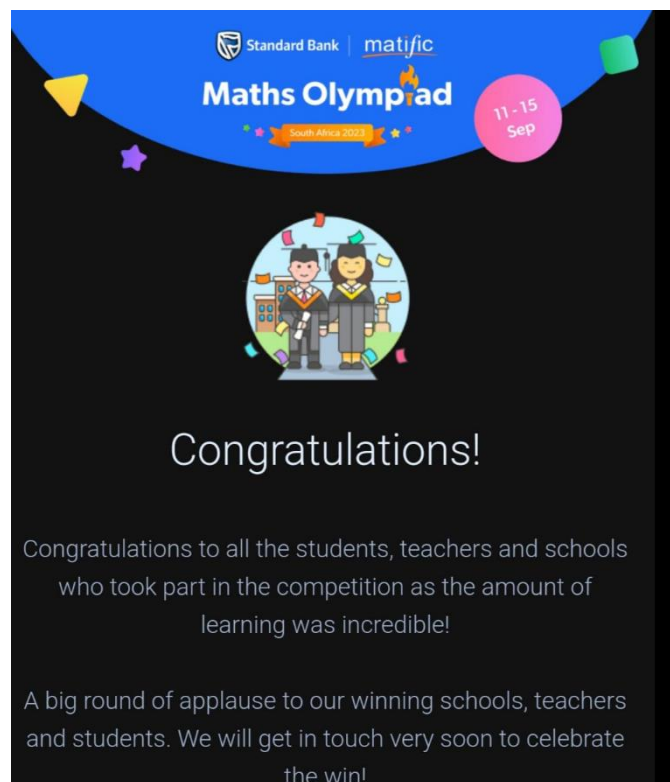
Well done to all our learners who took part in the Matific Olympiad 11 – 15th September 2023.

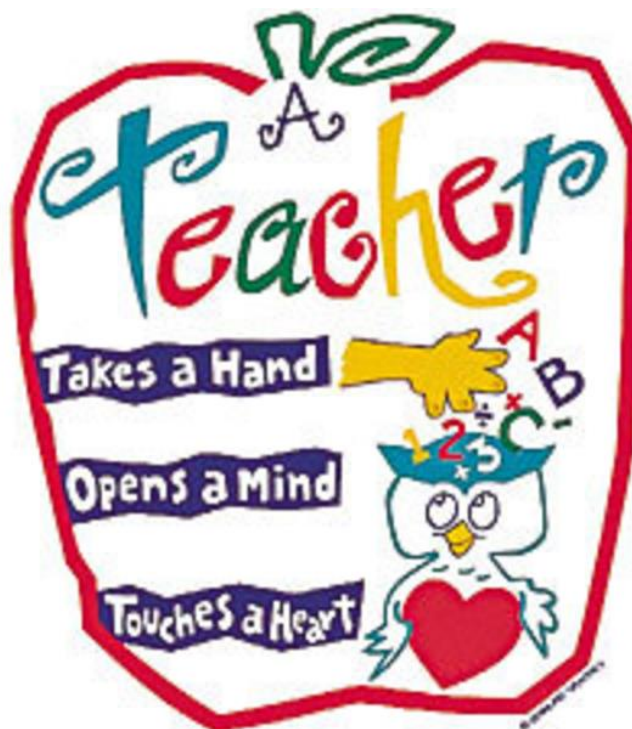

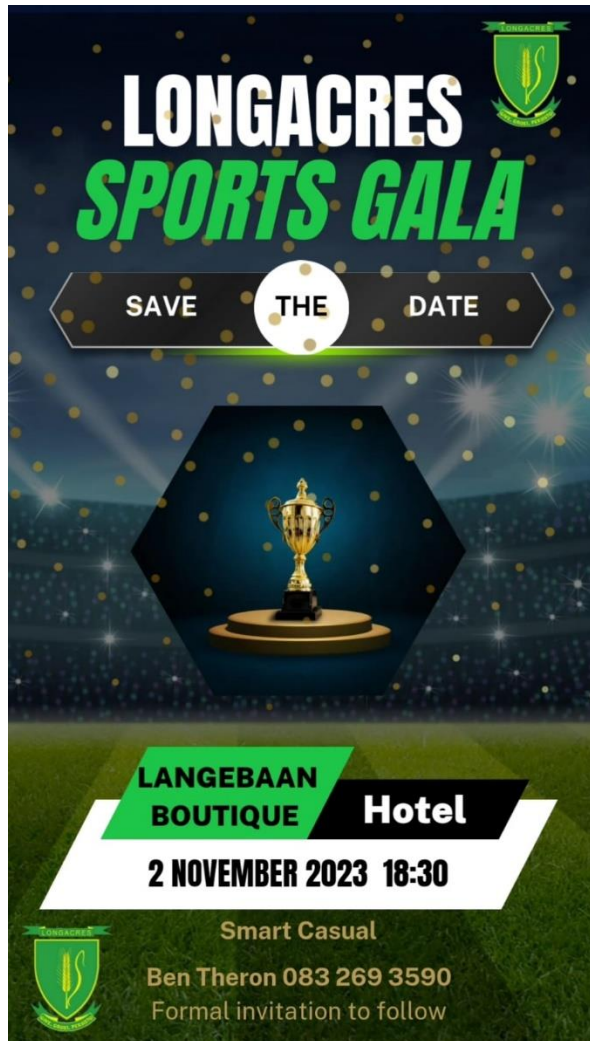
The foundation phase group will play on the left side of the rugby field and the senior phase group will play on the right side of the rugby field.
